For each position, a Ph.D. in chemistry (or biochemistry) is required and postdoctoral experience is highly preferred. The ideal candidates will have a strong interest in teaching and research involving undergraduates and a desire to belong to a collegial, vibrant department committed to excellence in the classroom, in the research lab and in P-12 outreach. The candidates will be expected to develop a research program suitable for undergraduate participation with a strong likelihood of external funding and can expect start-up research funds.
