- Develop other programs to help partners to achieve targeted corporate objectives related to the hiring and training of scientists of color.

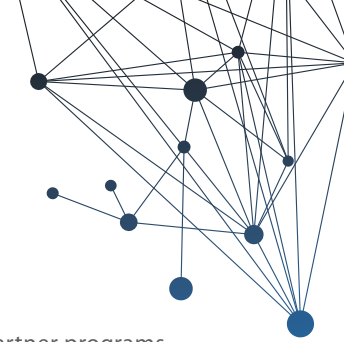
