



Instructor/Assistant Professor of Chemistry (16-35)

The Chemistry Department at Francis Marion University invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure track Instructor/Assistant Professor of Chemistry. The position is renewable at the discretion of the University for up to two additional years. Rank and salary depend on qualifications.

Teaching responsibilities typically involve two general chemistry lectures and three lab sections per semester. Research and professional service are encouraged.

For this position, a Ph. D. in Chemistry is preferred, but candidates who are nearing completion of the doctorate or hold a Master's degree in Chemistry will be considered.
