

The Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at Bates College, a private, highly selective liberal arts college in Maine, invites applications for a one-year, full-time visiting assistant professor of chemistry in any specialty area beginning August 1, 2020. Candidates who have demonstrated success working with underrepresented and marginalized populations are encouraged to apply. Teaching responsibilities include introductory chemistry I and II, introductory chemistry laboratories, and an elective of the candidate's choice. The opportunity exists to mentor undergraduate thesis research projects, but this is not required.

Bates College and the Chemistry and Biochemistry Department are increasing inclusivity across the campus and in the curriculum. We especially welcome applications from all individuals with the ability to contribute to the college's continuing commitment to social and cultural diversity and the transformative power of our differences.

Review of applications begins on March 1, and will continue until the position is filled.

A Ph.D. or A.B.D in chemistry and a strong commitment to teaching undergraduates in a liberal arts setting are required. Applications should include the following:

- a cover letter that addresses what interests you about working at a small, residential, liberal arts college
- a current CV
- a brief statement describing your teaching philosophy and how you will support a diverse and inclusive classroom.
- graduate school transcripts
- three letters of recommendation, at least one of which discusses qualities that will support your role as a teacher.
