

## FACULTY POSITION IN ORGANIC CHEMISTRY

The Department of Chemistry & Chemical Biology at IUPUI (<http://chem.iupui.edu/>) invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position in **organic chemistry** to begin August 1, 2020. The position is open to applicants from all areas of organic chemistry.

The position will be at the rank of Assistant Professor. The successful candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in organic chemistry. Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in Chemistry or a related discipline along with relevant post-doctoral experience. Candidates must demonstrate the ability to initiate and sustain an externally funded program of research, and to teach effectively at the undergraduate and graduate levels. We especially seek candidates whose research interests can support and expand the department's efforts to complement campus-wide interdisciplinary research programs in the life and health sciences, including ongoing collaborative efforts with the IUPUI School of Science and the (on campus) Indiana University School of Medicine.

Applicants should submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, statements of research plans and teaching philosophy, and the names and contact information for three references. Interested candidates should submit their application using peopleadmin site (<https://indiana.peopleadmin.com/postings/>). Review of applications will begin on October 15, 2019 and will continue until the position is filled.
