

Faculty Position in Biophysics-Assistant Professor

The T.C. Jenkins Department of Biophysics, Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Maryland (<https://biophysics.jhu.edu/>) invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor in the broad area of Molecular and Cellular Biophysics. We encourage applicants with experimental, theoretical, and/or computational approaches for understanding biomolecular physical chemistry, structure, function, and assembly. We seek faculty colleagues who have an established interest in promoting equity and inclusion among diverse scientists at any level.

Our search is structured to minimize bias and provide equal opportunity to all applicants. In the initial evaluation stage, all statements on research, teaching, and DEI will be anonymized. In the second stage, all information from selected applicants will be considered, including full CV and letters of recommendations.
