- Monitors equity initiatives for staff and faculty

- Oversees equipment acquisition
- Has oversight of Undergraduate Experiential Learning Initiative
- Manages special projects assigned by the Dean
- Guides efforts for mentoring of faculty within departments
- Represents the College at campus meetings in Dean's absence

Required Qualifications Include:

- Possess an earned doctorate, or its foreign equivalent in a discipline offered by the college.
- Provide evidence of scholarship that merits appointment as full professor with tenure.
- Have experience as a Department Chair (or Head)
- Provide evidence of a track record of commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion.
- Possess strong interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrate ability to perform administrative tasks.
