Applicants must hold a doctoral degree in chemistry or closely related field with the degree conferred no later than the position start date of August 15, 2022. Applicants should be able to teach to a diverse student body. In addition to excellent teaching, the successful candidate is expected to establish an active research program that will include undergraduate students, exposing them to current research techniques.
