

Assistant Laboratory Professor (Organic Chemistry)

The Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry invites applications for a renewable position to begin fall 2021. Applicants should have a Ph.D. (preferred) or M.S. in chemistry. Experience teaching organic chemistry laboratory is expected. Responsibilities include the preparation, teaching, and grading of organic chemistry I and II laboratory sections, as well as the design and implementation of new laboratory experiments. The renewable position will begin with an initial one-year appointment starting August 2021.

The statement on inclusion should address how your teaching, mentorship, and/or community service demonstrate a commitment to and/or evidence of engaging with issues of diversity and inclusion.
