The Pritzker School of Molecular Engineering (PME) is a unique interdisciplinary school launched by the University of Chicago in 2011 with the aim of translating molecular and quantum science into technological solutions with potential societal impact in health and immunology, energy/water/materials and environmental sustainability, and quantum information technology. An independent unit within the university, PME is also affiliated with Argonne National Laboratory, and joint appointment is encouraged when appropriate.

Successful candidates will be expected to establish and maintain a strong research program and to teach at the graduate and undergraduate levels.
