

## Tenure Track/Tenured Faculty Position in Integrated Energy Systems

The Pennsylvania State University is recruiting for a new tenure track/tenured faculty position at the Assistant or Associate professor level in Integrated Energy Systems (IES) as a part of its strategic initiative to further enhance its status as an international leader in energy research and education. This new hire will join the department most relevant to their research and teaching interests in the College of Engineering. Areas of expertise that are of particular interest for this position include: renewable energy systems and technologies; carbon capture and recycling; smart electrical grid systems for balancing loads; water systems related to energy production; electrolyzers and other electrochemical systems. All IES faculty have outstanding opportunities for collaboration through this and other consortia, the Institutes of Energy and Environment, and the Materials Research Institute.

Applicants should have a Doctoral degree by the start of the appointment in a field related to one of the three IES topics. Appointments will be made at a rank commensurate with experience. Successful applicants will be researchers who can work across disciplines in a team to advance the science and engineering of energy systems.

To apply, submit a single pdf file containing: (1) a cover letter indicating at least one preferred home department in COE; (2) the names and addresses of four references; (3) a full curriculum vitae containing a complete list of publications; (4) separate statements of research, teaching interests, and commitment towards diversity and inclusion; (5) copies of three published journal papers. Review of applicants will begin on **December 15, 2020**, and will continue until the positions are filled.
