

### **Lecturer (non-tenure track position)**

The Department of Chemistry at Rice University seeks applicants for a full-time (9-month) Lecturer position in Chemistry. This non-tenure track position has an anticipated start date of July 1, 2019.

Duties primarily include teaching general chemistry laboratories at the undergraduate level. Other teaching assignments are possible, dependent on departmental needs and candidate qualifications. Some service/committee assignments are also expected.

A doctoral degree in chemistry or a related field and previous teaching experience (preferably at the university level) are required. We welcome applicants with backgrounds in all areas of chemistry.

In addition to the application, the following items must be uploaded:

- 1) Cover Letter
- 2) Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 3) Statement of Teaching Interests

Each applicant must provide the names and e-mail addresses of three references who can provide letters addressing the applicant's abilities as an instructor. RICEWorks will automatically generate e-mails to the references with a link to allow direct upload of recommendation letters.

Review of applications will begin April 1, 2019, and will continue until the position has been filled. Candidates are encouraged to apply before this date.
