

## Teaching Assistant Professor Faculty Position in Chemistry at UNC Chapel Hill

The Department of Chemistry at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill invites applications for a teaching assistant professor faculty position. In addition to covering our introductory courses in general chemistry, instructional areas of particular interest include inorganic and biophysical chemistry. Applicants must have completed a PhD in Chemistry, Chemical Education, or a related field, must have demonstrated excellence in teaching lecture and/or laboratory courses, and have an interest in advancing and publishing educational innovations. This position is a full-time, benefits eligible, 9-month, fixed-term faculty position with an initial appointment of four years.

Education Requirements: PhD, MS or MS/PhD in Chemistry

Only electronic applications will be accepted. Applicants should submit a single pdf document that includes a cover letter, a *curriculum vitae*, names of four professional references (with titles, email addresses and phone numbers), commitment to inclusive teaching statement and a teaching philosophy statement. Applicants should also upload a ten-minute teaching video on a chemistry-related subject of their choice.
