<b>Duties:</b>	Teaching responsibilities will include teaching a load of six three-credit courses per year (three courses per semester), including lectures and labs for General Chemistry I and II, as well as Physical Chemistry I and II. The candidate will be expected to develop research projects with undergraduate chemistry and biology students. In addition, the position involves related duties such as student advising, program assessment, continuing professional development, university committee work, and departmental duties.
<b>School:</b>	The Department of Biological Sciences is within the College of Arts and Sciences has offices and labs in Browning Hall, Interdisciplinary Sciences Building. This facility includes Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Exercise Science teaching laboratories and associated spaces as well as research facilities for student/faculty collaborative research. The College's 70 full-time faculty and eight departments offer fifteen graduate programs of study and more than 25 undergraduate programs. The College offers programs at over 30 locations throughout the United States and at six international sites.
