

Assistant Professor of Chemistry and Biochemistry, Tenure Track (Analytical Chemistry)

The Chemistry and Biochemistry Department of Nazareth University of Rochester, New York invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor to begin August 2024. The department seeks candidates committed to undergraduate teaching excellence at a comprehensive institution that supports both liberal arts curricula and professional programs. Candidates will develop a strong research program involving undergraduate students. Applicants should have a Ph.D. in Analytical Chemistry or a closely related field and experience educating diverse populations of students.

The successful candidate is expected to teach Analytical Chemistry with Laboratory, General Chemistry or General Physics, and Preparatory Chemistry for non-majors. Teaching responsibilities may also include upper-level electives in their area of expertise, and courses in the college core curriculum.

Review of completed applications will begin January 2024 and continue until the position is filled.

- A teaching philosophy
- A statement of research plans suitable for undergraduate participation (3 page maximum)
- A curriculum vitae
- Copy of graduate-level transcripts
- The names and contact information for three professional references (including at least one that can address your teaching experience and one that can address your experience working with diverse groups).
